

3 Easy Steps - FREE Math Placement Test

Step 1: Register yourself and your child

A parent or guardian registers as a new user. At the time of registration you will need to enroll your child. You will also need to select a grade level you will like your child to be tested on. Please note that you can enter more than one child at the time of registration or you can add a child at a later time when you log into our online testing system. You will assign a unique **user id** and **password** for each child.

Step 2: Have your child take the MATH placement test

Once you have added your child, a child logs into the system using his/her own user id and password. Child then completes the test online. Please note that our system will test your child on two consecutive grade levels. Part A of the test is a lower grade and Part B of the test is the next upper grade. A child must complete both parts in order to generate a final performance report.

Step 3: Receive and review your child's performance reports

Once your child has successfully completed both parts, Part A and Part B, of the exam, you will receive a report in a .PDF format attached to the email you specified at the time of registration.

NOTE:

Please note that you and child will be able to review any completed exam and review each question on the exam along with the correct answer choice and the selection made by your child.

You will also be able to log into our system and view several other more detailed reports for each child.

MATH Placement Test Report Description

This report described your child's performance on both parts (lower grade level and upper grade level) of the exam. The report described child's performance in each one of the major categories tested on the exam for each grade level.

First part of the report describes the number of correct answers along with points earned.

Next the report describes performance in each one of the major MATH skill set areas. It states the number of correct and incorrect answers to questions on the test by each major MATH skill area.

The report then described the points earned in each MATH skill set area.

Finally, the report then compares your child's performance in each MATH skill set area compared to a recommended level.

The report also provides recommendations about highly interactive MATH curriculum products that will help your children improve their performance in the areas of weakness that were identified on the report.
